Francesc has developed his professional career in the fields of ergonomics, biomechanics, accessibility and Design for All, a concept that has been disseminated at the international level via EIDD - Design for All, of which he was President from 1998 to 2001, the Design for All Foundation until 2021, of which he was founder and President.

Francesc was responsible for urban accessibility for Barcelona City Council during the construction of the facilities for the Olympic Games of 1992. In 1993 he took on the management of the Resource and Documentation Consortium for the Integration of Diversity until 2000.

Author of the “European Concept for Accessibility” (2003 edition) and “Universal Design: The HUMBLE Method for User-Centred Business” (December 2011), and co-author of “ECA for Administrations” (2008), “Design for All in progress, from theory to practice” (ECA 2013) and “Destinations for All” (ECA 2017).

As a consultant, he has contributed to several European Union funded research projects in the fields of housing, co-design and tourism and he has participated in standards and legislation development for CEN and CENELEC, AENOR, AFNOR, Singapore, Catalonia, the Emirate of Dubai and Turkey, among others.

He is also Chief Executive of ProAsolutions, SL (Spain), Associate of ProAsolutions in Portugal, Trustee of the Barcelona Creativity and Design Foundation (BCD), Councillor of the International Association for Universal Design in Japan), honorary member of EIDD - Design for All, of the European Concept for Accessibility Network (EuCAN), and founder of the Asociación Española de Ergonomía (Spanish Ergonomics Association).
